What to Expect: On the eastern border of Lompoc and hidden behind an RV campground is a picturesque park that lies against the backdrop of the Santa Ynez River and active agricultural fields to the east.

Park Description: In addition to a popular walking and jogging trail, River Park amenities include individual picnic areas, horseshoe pits, sand volleyball courts, grassy open space areas,

playgrounds, and a small man-made fishing pond that attracts an abundance of wildlife.

Things to Do: Walking, birding, wildlife viewing, fishing, picnicking, cycling, and running.

Trailhead: CA-246 & Sweeney Rd, Lompoc, CA 93436

Directions: From the City of Santa Barbara, follow Hwy 101 north for 33 miles to exit 132. Take exit 132 for Hwy 1 toward Lompoc/Vandenberg Air Force Base. Follow Hwy 1 towards Lompoc, CA for 20 miles. Turn right on Hwy 246

for 0.4 miles and then turn left on River Park Road. From the City of Buellton, take Highway 246 west for 15.7 miles and turn right on River Park Road. The trailhead is located 0.5 miles from the park entrance. More information at: <http://healthypeoplehealthytrails.org>

Amenities: Parking lot, benches, playground equipment, picnic tables, barbeque grills, horseshoe pits, sand volleyball courts and restrooms.

What to Bring: Map, sun protection, layered clothing, flashlight, first aid kit, water, snack, cellphone, personal identification.

Trail Etiquette: Have fun, be friendly and considerate. Leave what you find. Respect wildlife. Dispose of waste properly.
