Park Description: Depending on the time of the year visitors to Ocean Beach County Park can walk along the shoreline to Surf Beach. The park features a wildlife observation deck with interpretive displays and a telescope. Picnic tables playground equipment and are on-hand.

Things to Do: Walking, birding, wildlife viewing, beachcombing, and picnicking. Amenities: Public parking lot. Benches at train station and Ocean Beach County Park. Restrooms available.

What to Bring: Map, sun protection, layered clothing, flashlight, first aid kit, water, snack, cellphone, personal identification.

Trail Etiquette: Have fun, be friendly and considerate. Leave what you find. Respect wildlife. Dispose of waste properly.

**Driving Directions:** Surf Beach is approximately 9 miles west of Lompoc, CA. From Hwy 1 (H Street) in downtown Lompoc head west on Ocean Ave (Hwy 246) until you reach Park Road. Turn right on Park Road and park at the Amtrak Station.

**Travel By Train:** Surf is an Amtrak passenger rail station. It is served by Amtrak's Pacific Surfliner from San Luis Obispo to San Diego. For train schedule information visit the Amtrak web site: http://www.pacificsurfliner.com/
